Several workshops, seminars and symposia are planned for both new and experienced educators to keep them stay abreast of contemporary educational practices and their advantages.

CII Leadership Programme



Along with the Confederation of Indian Industries (CII) we have built systems, tools and services to improve the quality delivery of an organisation. Our school is in the process of getting accreditation from NABET (National Accreditation Board of Education and Training). Through CII Institute of Quality, our teachers participated in training workshops on effective administration and learnt the need for constant review and revision.

Trinity English Workshop



Our teachers are encouraged to take up Trinity College London's Graded Examination in Spoken English (GESE). The process emphasises on language functions and skills and meets the grade-level content standards while fully participating in their classroom teaching. Today, through our continuous efforts all existing teachers at Shree Niketan have been awarded Trinity Grade Certification.

Story Telling Workshop

Enriching CII workshop at Singapore



Through CII Institute of Quality, our teachers went to Singapore for studying the education system and bring the best practices back home. The entire programme was focused on three crucial areas of leadership, in the shape of three modules, each dealing with significant, outcome-oriented factors viz., facilitative leadership, instructional leadership and institutional leadership.

A “Class Apart”: Skill Development and Competency Enhancement Programme by Kuruvilla Jacob Initiative



This programme is conducted every year to help teachers stay up-to-date with current thinking in pedagogy, to reinforce the teachers' confidence in their career choices and to make them more aware and knowledgeable about the nuances of early childhood education and become completely available to the children in the classroom.

Developing Computer Skills



In order to make our teachers more tech-savvy, our ICT department conducts workshops on developing computer skills and adopting ICT in teaching-learning process.

Training Program on Dyslexia Facilitated by MDA



Dyslexia is a hidden learning disability and bringing awareness about this is crucial. One in five children may have dyslexia causing them to struggle with reading and spelling. Research shows that every teacher is likely to have one or two dyslexic children in his or her classroom today. This training is specially designed to identify and help children with dyslexia. As a part of it, each day, specific modules on the different learning disabilities like reading, spelling, writing and/or Mathematics etc and the remedial methods for a child with dyslexia to cope with, were addressed in the workshop.

Education Leadership (ELP)



ELP programme by CEMD, New Delhi conducted by Spirit of Leadership (SOL), New Delhi, the main objectives of ELP are to facilitate change by developing leaders and institutions and provide effective and empowering leadership. The programme aims to provide the skills, knowledge and attitudes necessary for school principals and administrators to shape the future of schools and their students.

Teacher Recognition Programme



In order to recognise the efforts of our teachers who have put in their best and who go beyond their call of duty to help students perform better and the innovative practices adopted to make learning easy for our students, we reward our best teachers under various categories every year as a part of our Staff Enrichment Programmes.

OUTBOUND EDUCATIONAL TOURS

Educational trips are crucial to the learning of a child. Our experiential tours provide an opportunity for the students to be cognitively engaged as they explore areas of personal interest.



ADVENTURE CAMPS

Shree Niketan along with Aavishkar India, had designed an adventure and fun-filled four-day outdoor trip to Civet Creek and Coorg in Karnataka. Star gazing, camping in tents, day and night trekking, rappelling rock climbing rope activities learning about the flora and fauna of the location were among the few activities planned for the students. Students had an enriching experience during their adventure camp.



KALPAKKAM VISIT

The students are taken on a one-day educational trip every year to Madras Atomic Power Station (MAPS) situated at Kalpakkam about 80 kilometres south of Chennai. The students came to know about how nuclear power production takes places in nuclear power plant and about fuel reprocessing.

ISRO

A 3-day ISRO Visit trip was organized in the year 2019. Around 45 students from class IX and XI along with 5 staff visited ISRO. The visit to the planetarium kindled the curiosity of our students. The trip gave them an opportunity to bridge the gap between the theoretical and the practical knowledge. Students visited ISRO Research Centre, Nehru Planetarium, Musical Academy, Botanical Garden, VIT Museum, National Airforce Training Centre and Iskon Temple.



DAKSHIN CHITRA VISIT

Every year students are taken on a 2-day camp to Dakshin Chitra, an exciting cross cultural museum, located 25 kilometers to the South of Chennai. Students get a real life experience of the life pattern of Indians in the state of South India. They get an opportunity to engage themselves in the various traditional games like Nondi, Uriadi, etc. They also get to know about the varied and rich cultural heritage of South India.

RAJ NIVAS VISIT

As part of our Cultural Exchange Program, students from Denmark along with their Indian counterparts visited Raj Nivas. The students met the Honourable Lt. Governor of Puducherry, Dr. Kiran Bedi. The Danish students recited Thirukural and as well presented an English version of the Thirukural Book to Dr. Bedi.





Shree Niketan Schools has been placed in the Top 20 Category among 10,000 schools, which participated in Design for Change, in India. Design for Change is one of the largest global movement that empowers children in over 35 countries and over 3,00,000 students participate in it.



2011 **Maarg Sapasthaaga - Clean Revolution:**

This project of ours was placed in the Top Hundred Category.

Pollution is one of the biggest killers affecting more than 100 million worldwide. Through our first project our students brought the issue of pollution to limelight. Students adopted NGO colony and they spent two hours every day cleaning the area tirelessly in pursuit of providing clean environment.

2012 **Gana Bhandaar - Store house of knowledge**

We received the prestigious Special Jury Mention Award for this endeavor of ours.

Our students discovered that there were children who did not have access to good libraries. They came up with the idea to create functional libraries for children studying in schools that do not have libraries. Students collected a whopping number of 10,600 books. They shortlisted 5 schools in Tiruvallur where they set up libraries.

2012 **Shudharambh**

Students discussed the issue of sanitation and decided to bring a change in the housekeepers cleaning practices. They devised ways to implement and spread the message of hygiene to other schools as well.

2013 **Dekho, Pehchano, Kaho - A step towards freedom from child abuse**

This project fetched us a place in the Top 20 Category.

In the pursuit of creating awareness about identifying and fighting child abuse, our students conducted workshops in various schools in the vicinity of Thiruvallur. Ms. Kranti, an NGO, who rehabilitates children of sex workers was roped in to conduct an awareness program. Our students also contributed generously to help Shwetha Katti(a victim of child abuse) to pursue her higher studies in US.

2013 **Nithya Jeevitham**

This project of ours was placed in the Top 100 category.

Our students through their campaign were able to make the public realize the importance of donating organs. 75 parents and 30 teachers registered as organ donors following our student campaign.

2014 **Varsha jala sangrahana "Rainwater harvesting"**

When on an educational trip to a nearby village, our students witnessed barren lands and people standing in long queues to fetch water. This instigated our students to come up with the project to create awareness among the public to utilize rainwater better. Students collected data on RWH system, Conducted Rally, street play etc to create awareness.

2014 **Suraksha Prayanam** ***This project of ours was placed in the Top 20 category.***

One of the main factors in remaining safe on the roads is wearing helmet while driving. To create awareness on wearing helmet to save precious lives, our students conducted workshops, organized rallies and even donated helmets to teachers who were not wearing helmets while driving.

2015 **Jantu Samrakshana - Save Animals from Abuse**

We were placed in the Top 20 among 2512 stories across the country.

The pitiful state of street dogs was realized and through this project, feeding sites in 20 places were set up. An adoption drive was taken in which 20 puppies from streets were rescued and given foster homes.

2015 **Annam Na Nintyat (Food Wastage)**

Food issues could become as politically destabilizing by 2050 as energy issues are today. Our students felt the need to manage food sustainably and reduce waste. Our students organized a rally to create awareness among the public to prevent food wastage to avoid food shortage and visited hotels and restaurants to create awareness to prevent food wastage.

2016 **Saintha Tharasu - Fighting Gender Imbalance**

In light of the increasing rate of violence against women, our students decided to take up this issue and get to the root cause of it. They realized that to fight violence against women they have to first fight Gender inequality. Survey was conducted to find out the role of women and men in the household. Self Defense classes were organized for girl students. Eminent women achievers were brought in to educate the students on the role of gender and the misconceptions prevalent.

2017 **Ankiya Adikoshna Smirti (Digital Banking Awareness)**

Our students took up the project of Digital Banking Awareness to take banking to the door step of one village in our vicinity- Siruvannur Kandigai and educate the village people in handling technology used in the banking sector and show them the various schemes available to them from the government through the Banking Sector.

2018 **Running Dry - Leave some for our Children**

Our project was placed in the "Top 100 Category"

To create awareness amongst the residents within our vicinity about the apocalyptic scenario we will be facing in the future if we do not act today, our students came up with the DFC project-Running Dry-Leave some for our children. Our students came out with a variety of activities like drafting a modern conservation policy on how to prudently utilize water sources; sensitizing the farmers on rain water harvesting; reusing the spent reverse osmosis treated water in schools, houses, offices, hospitals and industries; monitoring the strict supply of drinking water in schools and offices at regular time intervals; taking responsibility in implementing the cleaning of certain water resources in Thiruvallur etc.

2019 **Traditional foods are roots to healthy life** ***This project of our was placed in the "Top 100 Category"***

Our students came out with a project titled "Traditional foods are roots to healthy life" necessitating the importance of taking traditional food in our daily intake. An array of activities were done by our students to create an awareness about this amongst the public.

1st ASIA PACIFIC GOJU RYU KARATE CHAMPIONSHIP / 5th AGKF CHAMPIONSHIP



Six students from Shree Niketan Group of Schools participated in The First Asia Pacific Goju Ryu Karate Championship and the Fifth AGKF Championship 2016 held at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. There were 1600 participants from 17 countries of which 140 were from India. Our students clinched one gold and 5 bronze medals. Our student, S. Tarun was the only student from India to have received a gold medal at the championship.

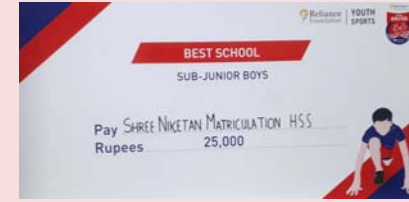
